Hegnsvej 2018-2019

Grusvejen Hegnsvej er en sidevej mod øst fra asfaltvejen Ny Høstemarkvej. Vejen går helt ud til landevejen mellem landsbyerne Dokkedal og Mou.

Fra Hegnsvej kunne man for få år siden få det fulde indtryk af det store tørvebrug, som den centrale del af Lille Vildmose bestod af i en generation. På begge sider af vejen gav produktionen af spagnum og tørv landskabet en karakteristisk rødbrun farve. Langs vejen blev der placeret store stakke af tørv eller store bunker af spagnum, som herfra blev hentet af togene med tipvogne eller senere af lastbiler, når det skulle fragtes ind til forarbejdning på fabrikken i Sønder Kongerslev.

Når man kender områdets tidligere brug, kan man fortsat genkende de mønstre af grave og strukturer, som blev dannet, da mosebruget fortsat var i gang, men i dag er den brune spagnum overflade erstattet af et sandt fugle-eldorado. Til fods, på cykel eller i bil kan man fra vejen iagttage et varieret fugleliv i de nu vandfyldte områder. Overalt er plantelivet igen ved at ændre sig til det, vi kender som vådområder.

I begge ender af vejen er der i dag opstillet tårne, hvorfra området kan beskues.

The road Hegnsvej 2018-2019

The dirt road Hegnsvej is a side road to the east from the road Ny Høstemarkvej. The road connects this road with the main road between the villages Dokkedal and Mou.

A few years ago, we could from the road Hegnsvej get the full impression of the large production of peat, which in a generation covered the central part of Lille Vildmose. On both sides of the road the production of sphagnum and peat gave the landscape a characteristic reddish-brown colour.

Along the road were placed stacks of peat or large piles of sphagnum, which here was picked up by the narrow-gauged trains with tipping waggons or later trucks when the sphagnum was transported to the processing factory in Sønder Kongerslev.

Knowing the former use of this landscape, you still can recognize the patterns of graves and structures that were formed, when the exploitation of the bog still was in progress, but today the reddish-brown peat surface is replaced by a green seabird paradise. From the road - on foot, by bike or by car - you can observe a variety of birdlife in the now flooded areas. Everywhere the flora again has changed the areas to a wetland.

The whole area can be viewed from towers at both ends of the road.

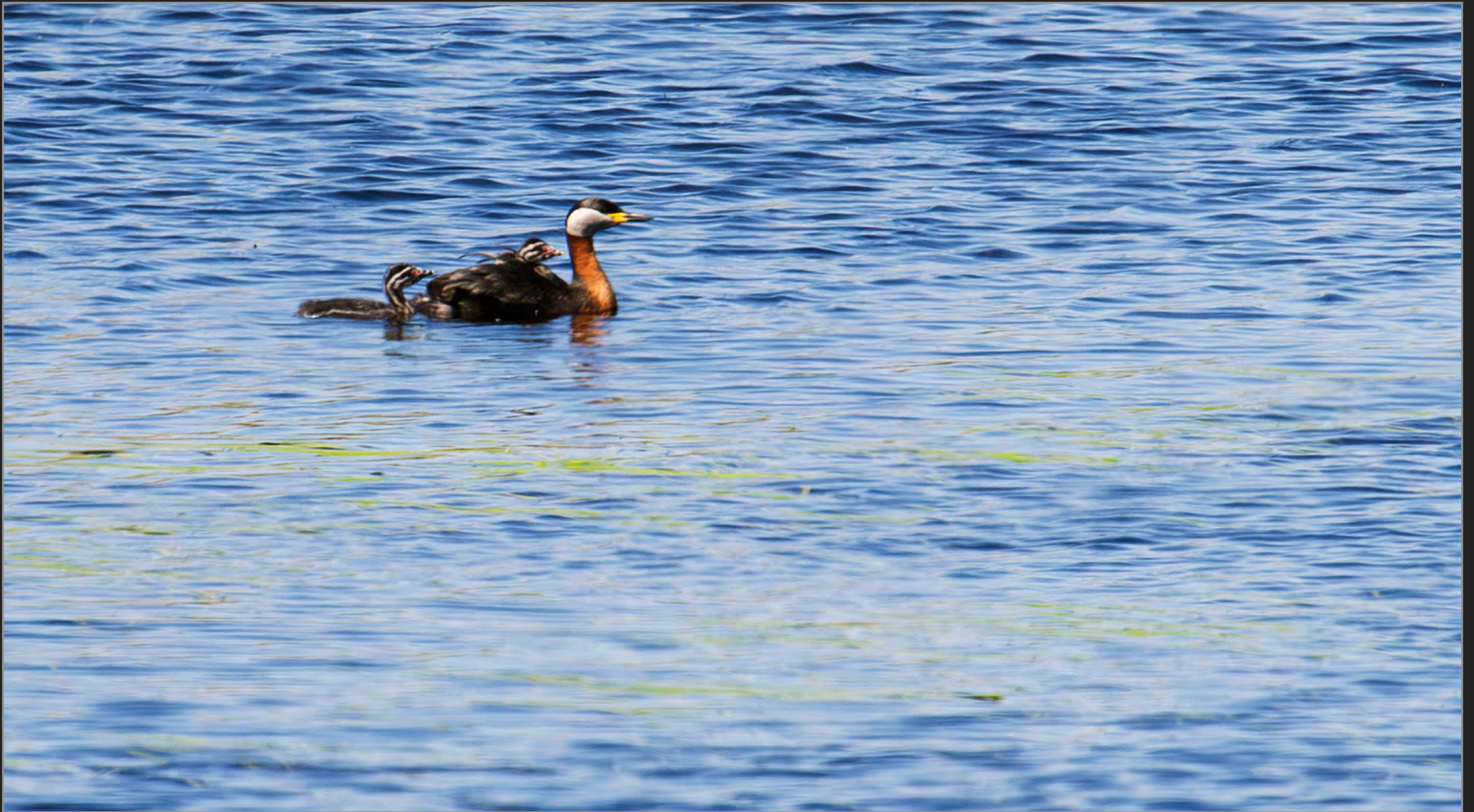

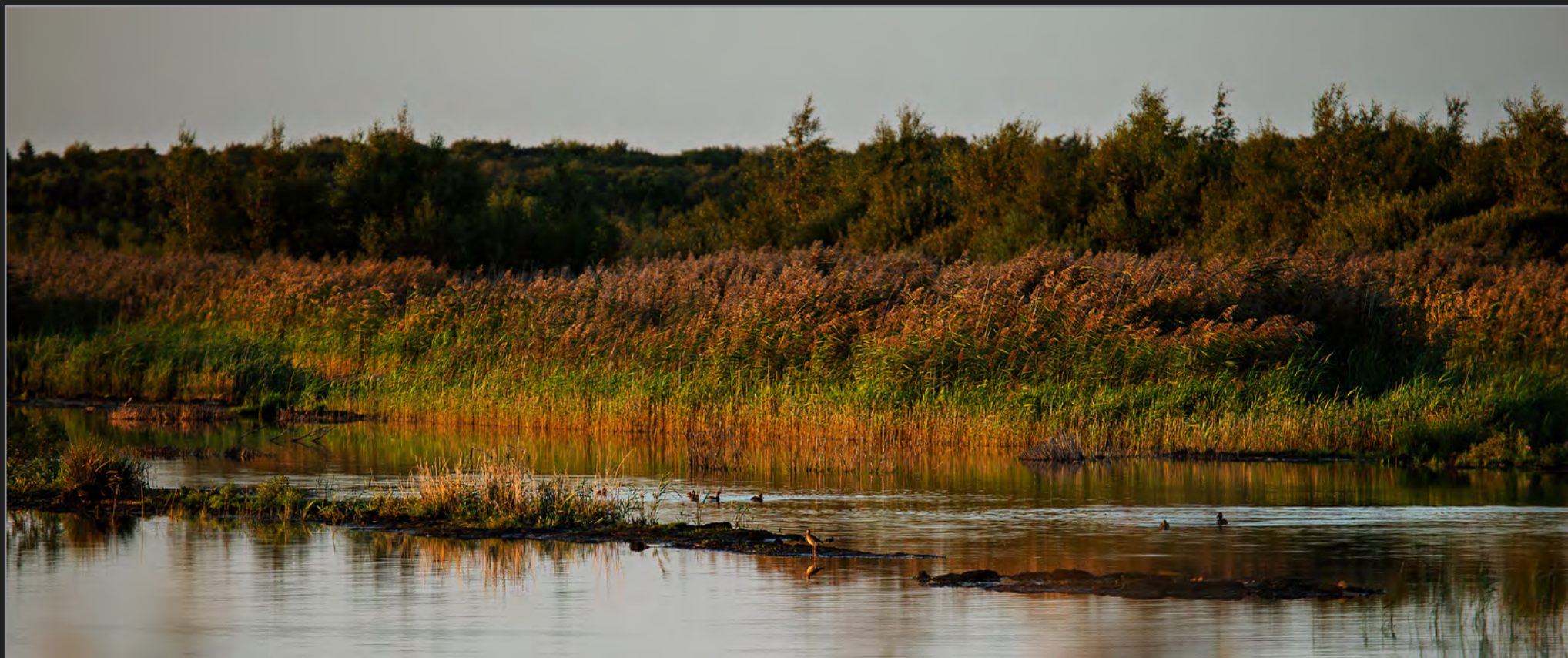
