Farthest towards the west at the edge of the bog stands the estate Kongstedlund. It is a manor house with a beautiful main building surrounded by farm buildings. From the manor house a dirt road leads into the bog and to the lake Toftesø. This piece of road is surrounded by fields, but also of forest in the edge of the bog. A chalk cliff is the borderline of the bog. Farther east, the road is bordered by scattered trees and large meadows, still used as grazing land for the cattle.

A ride by bicycle on this piece of road is one of the places in the bog I love the most. It is a ride with many interruptions. Frequently interesting birds or other animals require my attention. The camera must be activated and interesting subjects and compositions make its way to the viewfinder.

The seasons give this landscape different expression, but the landscape seems always fascinating. In the summer, my hunt with the camera is joined by the curious cattle. While I am trying to photograph a red-backed shrike with its young birds twenty heifers glance at me with their big brown eyes. They are a little shy, but I have often had a good conversation with them. They are good listeners, whether it concerns my private small everyday challenges or larger existential questions.
