Ny Høstemarksvej 2007-2009

This photo series from Lille Vildmose includes photographs recorded on the asphalt road Ny Høstemarksvej. The road runs across a large part of Lille Vildmose from north to south. Ny Høstemarksvej is at a distance of several kilometres a ruler-straight road.

If you move from south to north on New Høstemarksvej you on the left side have a view over the bog Portlandmosen. Portlandmosen was previously a place for production of peat to a cement work north of the area, but the area was many years ago abandoned and left as an attractive area of nature.

Previously, there was a growth of birch and other trees along the road, but they are now removed so that you know get a full view of the Portlandmosen from the road.

On the right side you look out over a huge area that previously was a production place owned by Pindstrup Mosebrug. Until a few years ago the area appears with peat stacks and with intermediate excavation. These excavates appears today as kilometres long, low-watered lakes filled with reptiles and birds.

Previously rails for a narrow-gauged railway were laid out along the road. The railway was used to transport peat from the bog up to the plant in Sønder Kongerslev.
