The harbour of Scrabster is an example of the active Scottish traffic and fishing harbour.









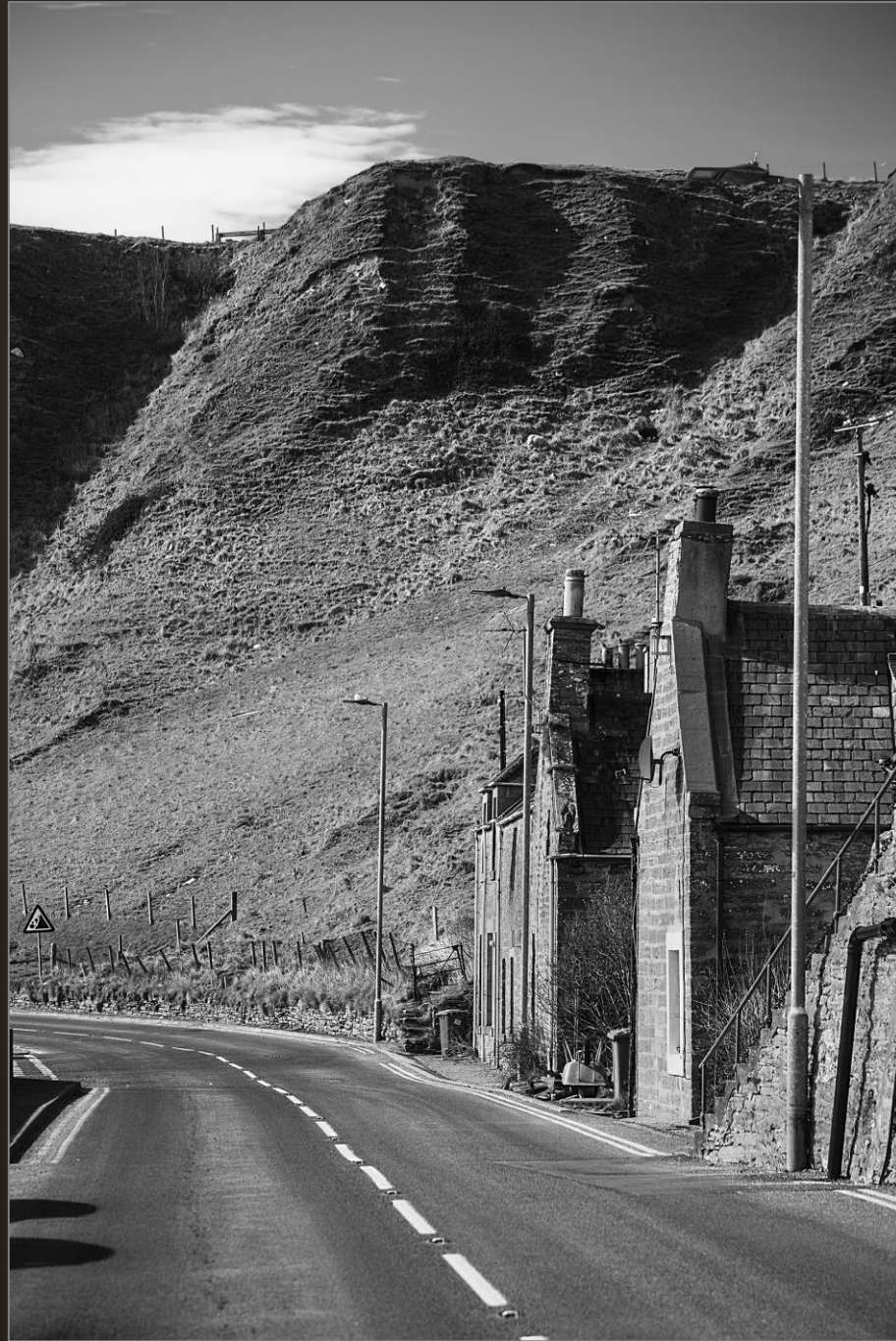






















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
