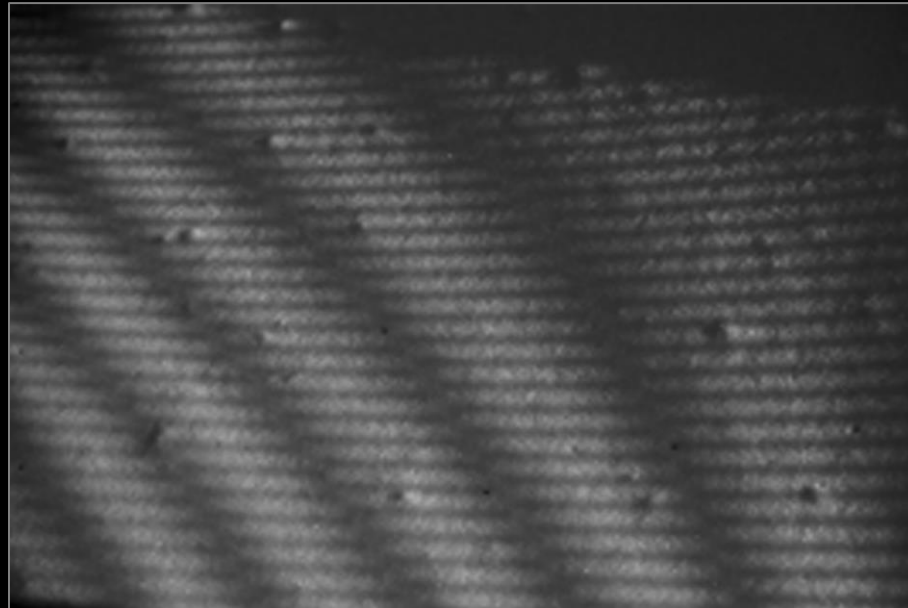

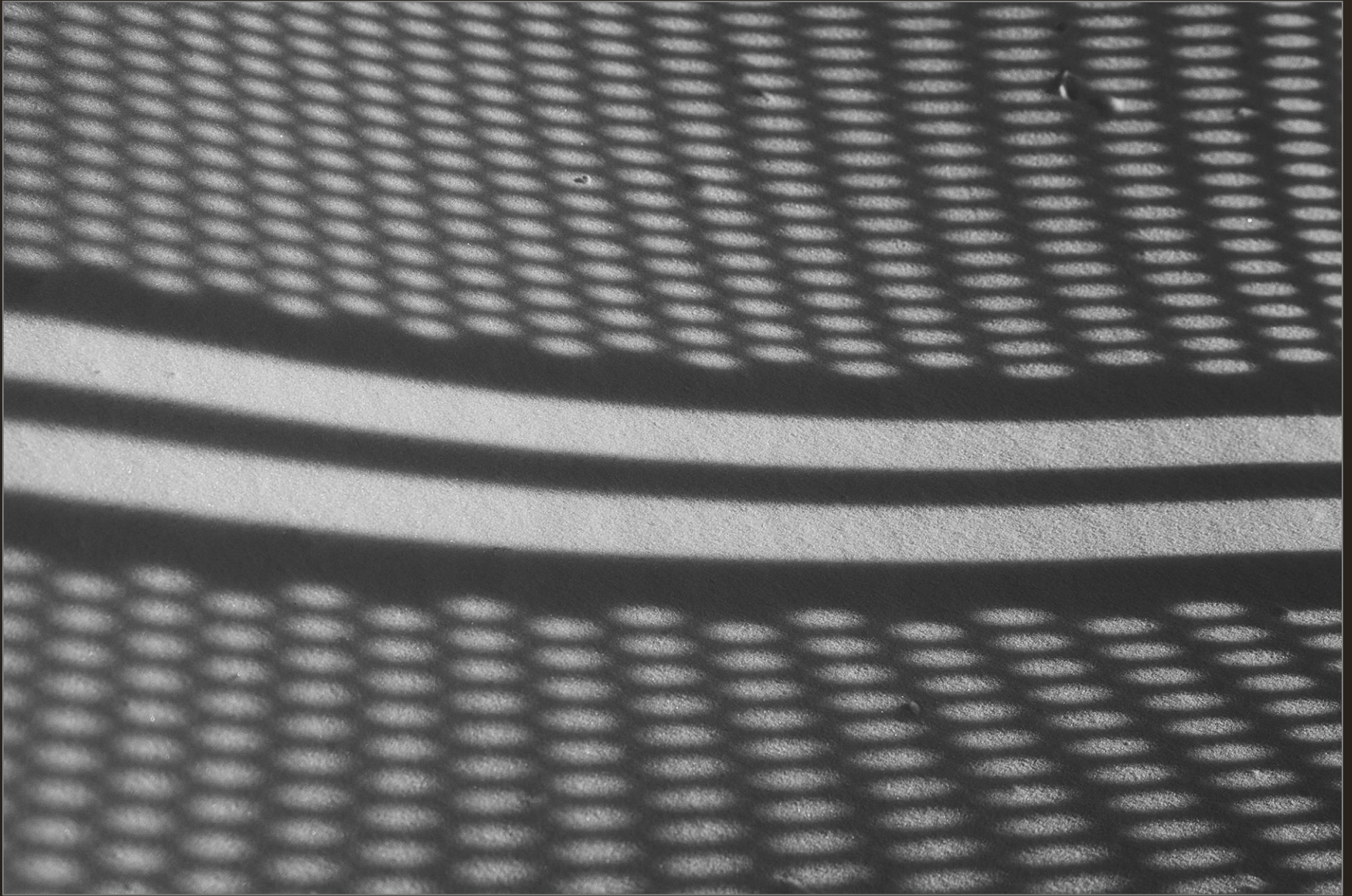

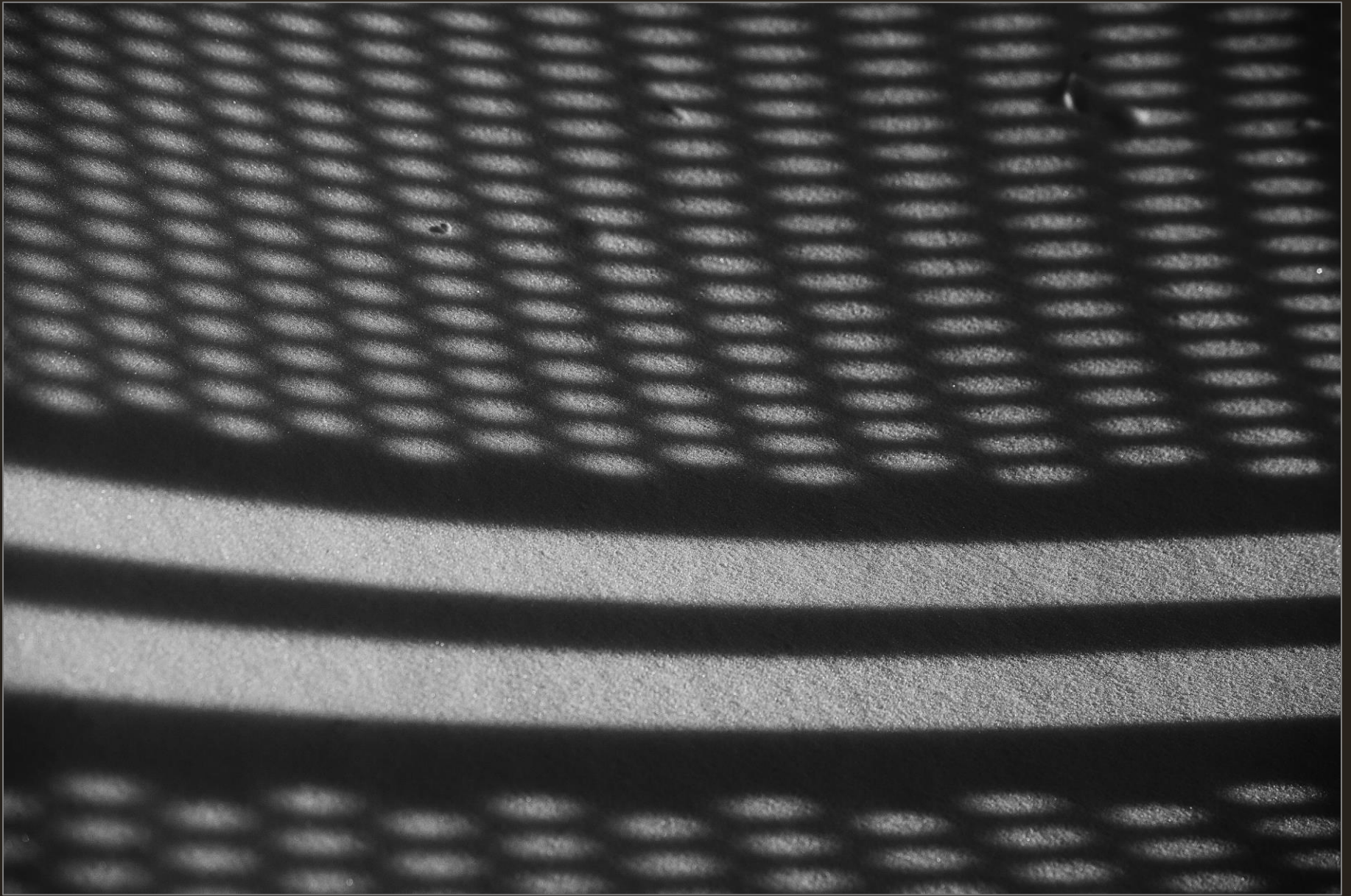
Shadow life

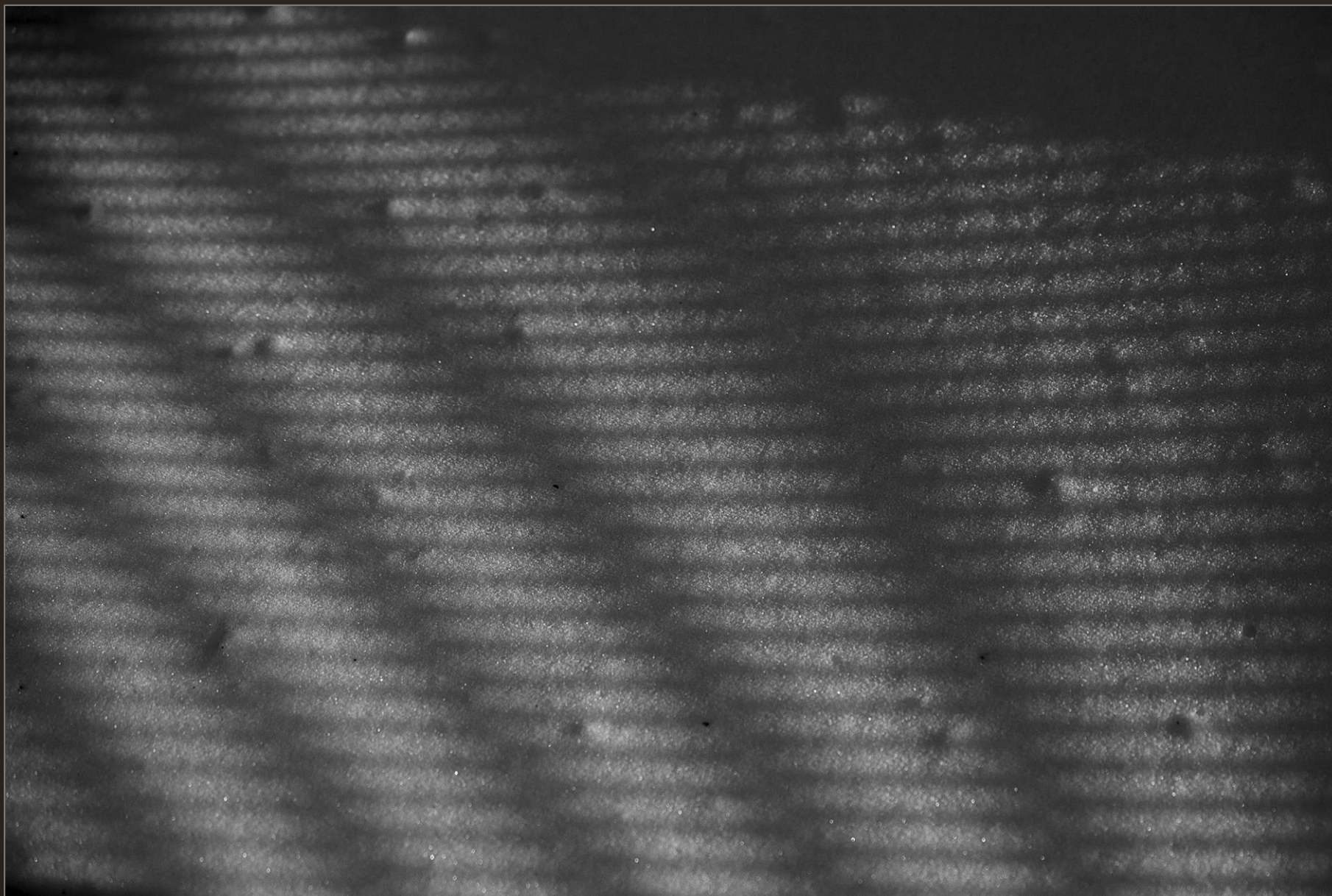
In the long Arctic winter, the sun is low and cold. Often it hides behind the highest mountains. Only once in a while it peeps out.
