Grusvejen

Det er ikke andet end en lang, lige grusvej. Det er et lille, ikke særligt befærdet stykke vej. Alligevel formår vejen at strække sig over to kommuner og to sogne.

Treskelvej forbinder landsbyen Skibsted med landsbyen Komdrup længere mod nord. Langs vejen er der marker, og der er frakørsler til forskellige gårde undervejs. Landskabet virker noget monotont med de store, bare markfelter mellem gårdene.

Denne dag er jeg på cykeltur og vil hurtigt snuppe de tre kilometer grusvej på min tur. Det bliver vanskeligere, end jeg forventer. Det grove grus er umuligt at cykle i, så det bliver i stedet for en lang gåtur med cyklen.

Til gengæld opdager jeg undervejs, at selv de

store øde markfelter, hvoraf nogle her i april fortsat ligger brak, er fyldt med liv. Sanglærken fylder mine ører med liflig sang hele vejen. Ude på markerne må lærkerederne ligge tæt. Bomlærken er også et sted derude, kan jeg høre. Humlebieerne summer i vej-kanten. De glæder sig nok til at blomsten på rapsplanterne springer helt ud, for så er der uendelige mængder nektar at sætte tryn i.

Undervejs skræmmer jeg også en flok agerhøns op. Det er lang tid siden, at jeg har oplevet denne sky markfugl. Herligt at vide, at den fortsat eksisterer her på egnen.

Jeg tager mig rigtig god tid og fotograferer de monotone og nu på sin vis smukke omgivelser langs den lille grusvej.

The unpaved road

It is nothing but a long, straight unpaved road. It is a small, not busy road. Nevertheless, the road manages to span two municipalities and two parishes.

The road, Treskelvej, connects the village of Skibsted with the village of Komdrup further north. Byroads connect a few farms along the road. The landscape seems somewhat monotonous with the large, bare fields between the farms.

This day I am on a bike ride, and on my trip, I will quickly take the three kilometres of unpaved road on my trip. The ride was more difficult than expected. It is impossible to ride a bicycle on the coarse gravel. Instead I wheeled my bicycle.

Then, walking along the road, I discover that even this vast fields, some of which remain

fallow at this time in April, are full of life. All the way I listen to the delicious singing of the lark. Out in the fields, the nests of the lark must be close to each other. Somewhere out in the fields, also the corn bunting utters a sound. At the roadside, the bumblebee is buzzing. Probably, the bee is looking forward to the opening of the flowers on the oilseed rape. Then there will appear endless amounts of nectar to place the snout in.

Along my walk on the unpaved road, I scare up a flock of common partridges. It is wonderful to discover that this unique bird still is remaining in my district.

I take my time over it and photographs the monotonous and now in some way feeling-good surroundings along this small unpaved road.
