Coriander in bloom

The month of August is drawing to a close. I take a walk in my garden. My raised beds have supplied me with many herbs this year. Parsley, chives, tarragon, lovage, coriander, thyme – ready to pick.

Now that the sun is shining, there is plenty to look at in my garden. The birds and insects are busy. Up in the wood, I can hear a larger animal moving around. Maybe a deer?

The weather radar tells us that clouds will soon be pulling in from the south. The clouds have thunder in them. It is summer weather.

Long since, my bed of coriander has gone into bloom. The plants stand long, rattle and vulnerable with the small white flowers. Soon, the small round seeds will be formed, and the plants will sow themselves for a new season. I use quite a good deal of coriander leaves and seeds in my food.

But right now, I also share the coriander with the insects in my garden. This afternoon there is bustle in and around the coriander flowers. It is swarming with insects which, like me, enjoy this special herb. Right now, the insects seem to be extra busy – maybe they already have got a scent of a change of weather?

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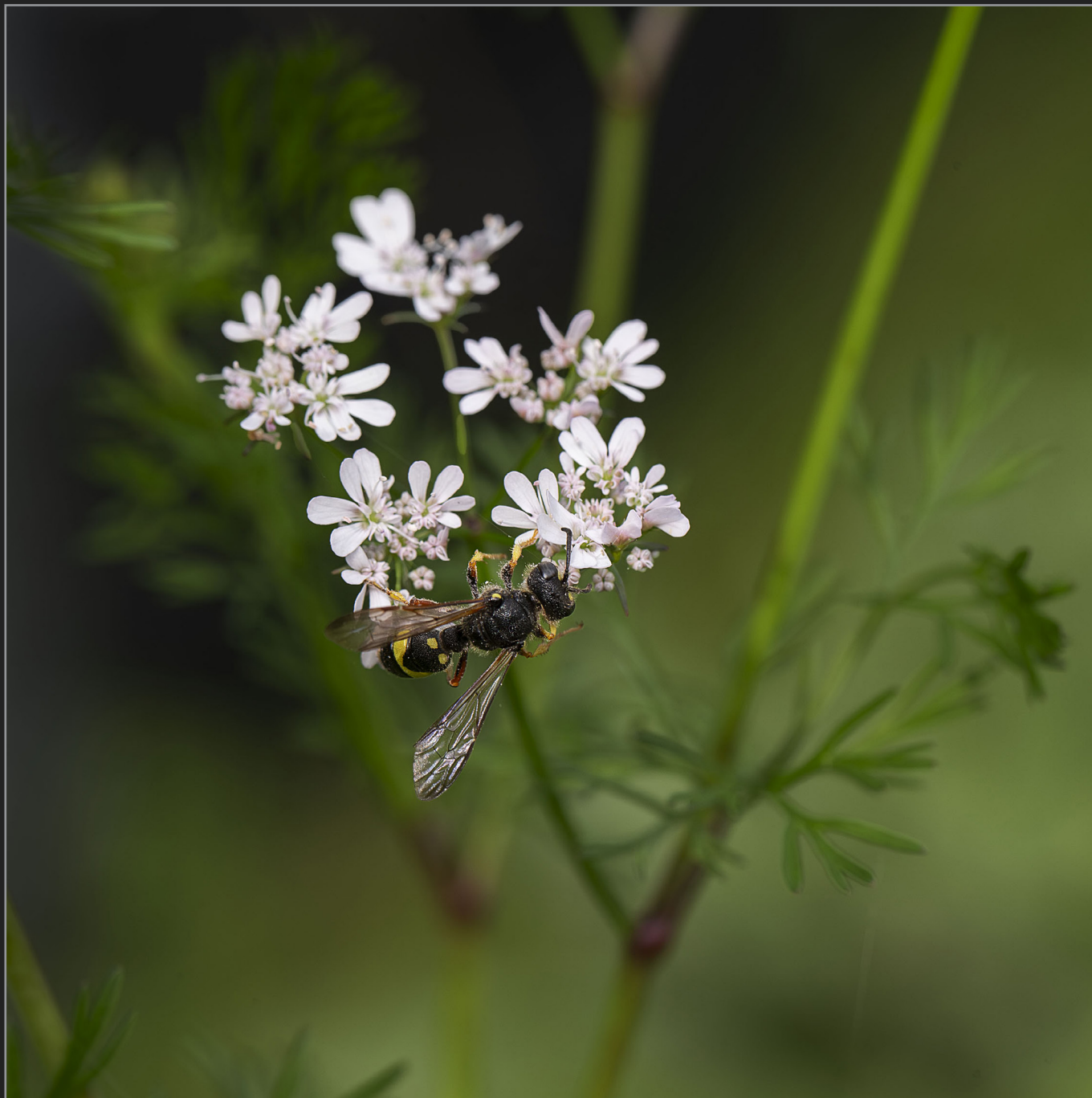
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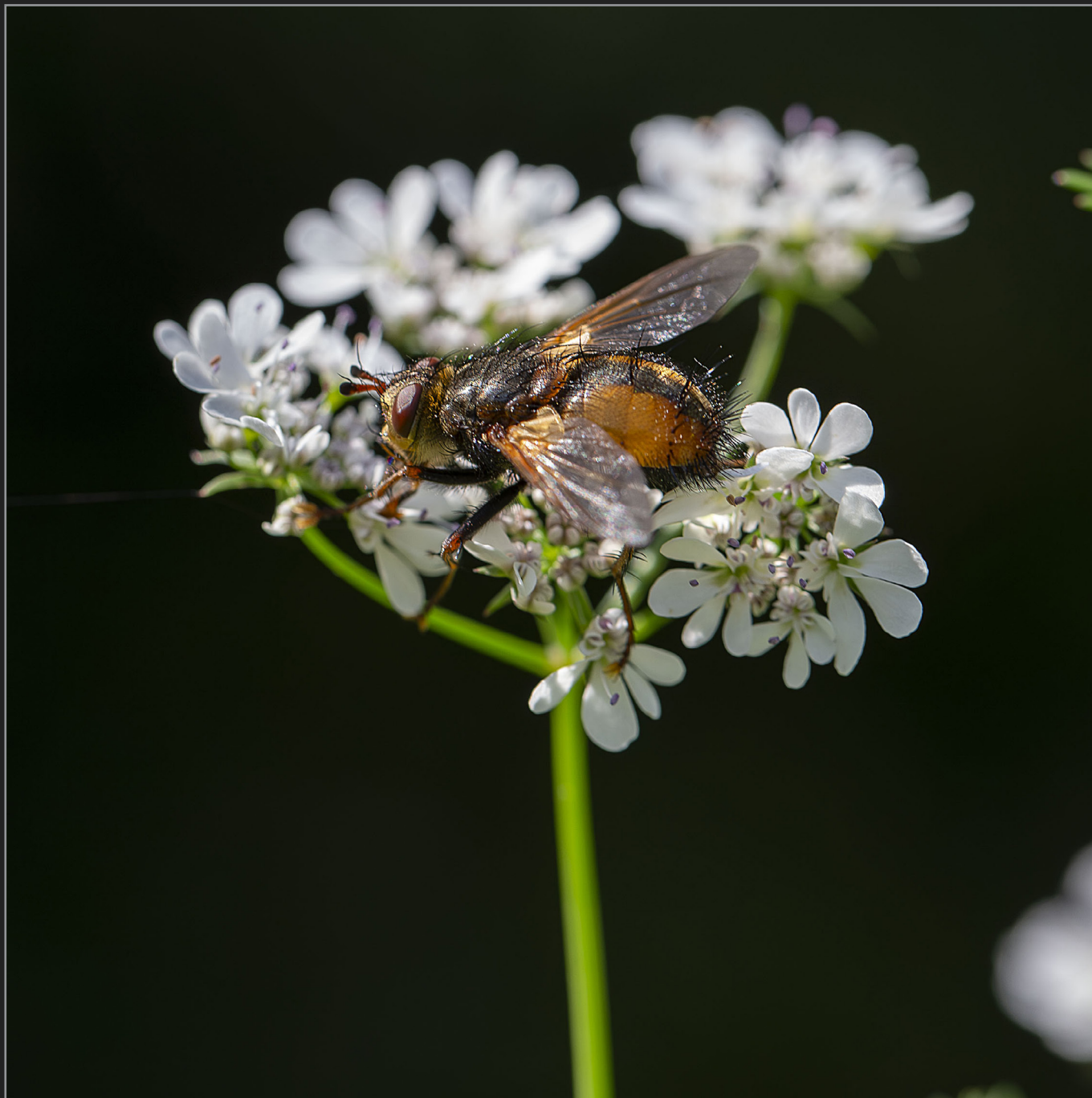
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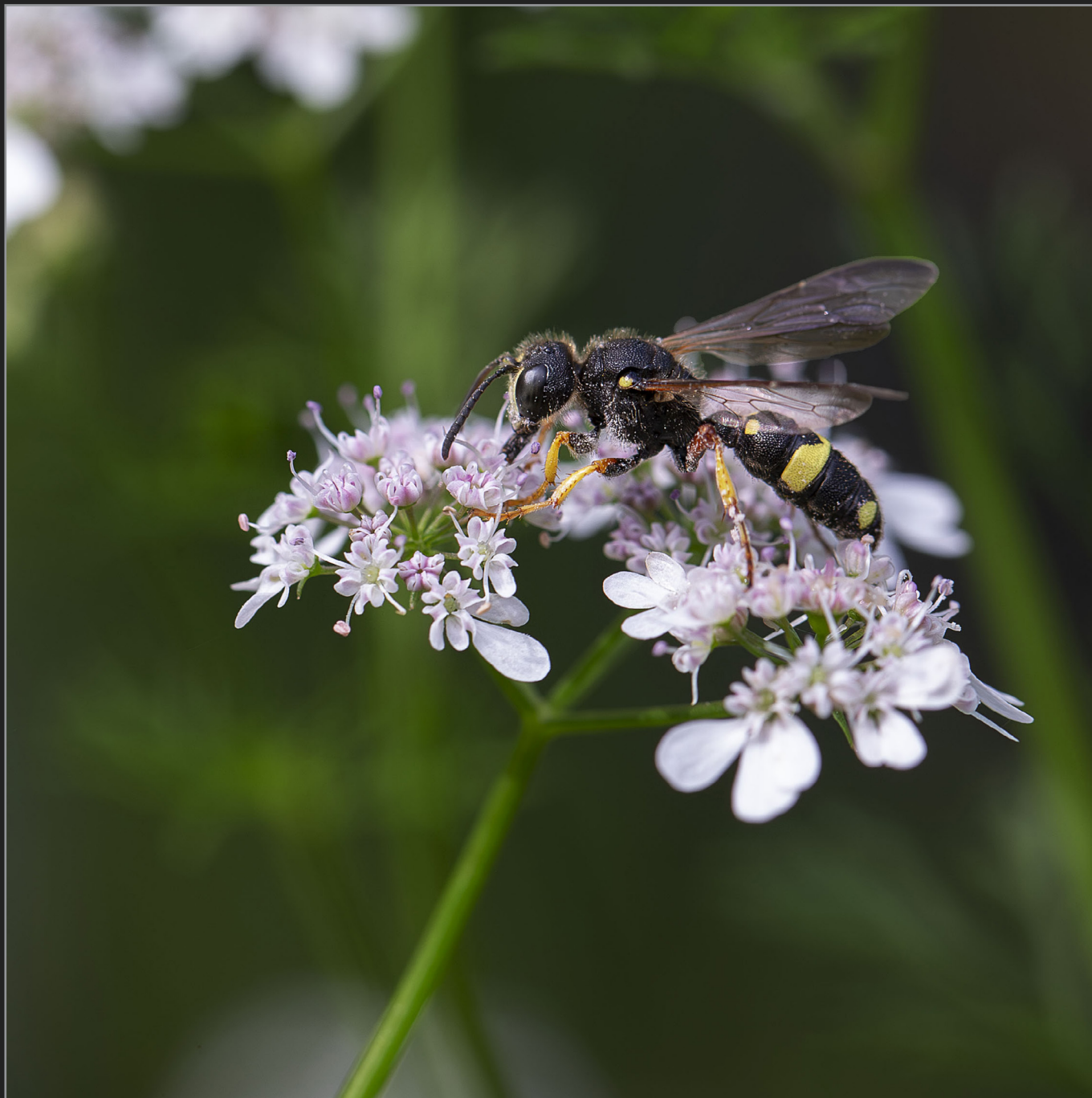
