In these years, this wildness in the nature has raised increased concern. The melting water is gushing from the Greenland Ice Sheet. Researchers have measured that the amount of melt water has more than doubled this year compared to just ten years ago. The consequences can be so large that many researchers believe that these unimaginable amounts of melt water will tilt the balance of nature in the oceans of the world.

This waterfall has such a force that the meltwater is broken in foam and clouds of water drops on the rocks. We watch this amazing sight in half an hour from our little boat. It is incomprehensible to imagine these enormous amounts of melting water for 24 hours around the clock bursts new melting water into our fiord.
